## MONTHLY INFORMATION

## on the performance of the NBS RTGS system, clearing system, and interbank and international clearing of foreign exchange payments in March

In the course of 23 business days in March, a total of 20.9 million payments were processed in the NBS RTGS (17.4 million or 83.2%) and clearing system (3.5 million or 16.8%). The average number of payments was 910,822 per day, of which 757,833 in RTGS and 152,989 in clearing.

The value of turnover in the RTGS system amounted to RSD 8,549,0 billion, while clearing turnover reached RSD 41.7 billion, or 0.5% of the total.

Daily turnover in the RTGS and clearing system averaged RSD 371.7 billion and RSD 1.8 billion respectively.

During the 12,825 minutes of production, there was no downtime and the availability of the NBS RTGS and clearing systems was 100.0%.
