

NBS RTGS and Clearing System Turnover and Number of Payments in May 2006

In the course of 21 business days in May 2006, a total of 13.62 million interbank orders worth CSD 1,200.97 billion were processed. Of that number, clearing orders accounted for CSD 72.06 billion or 6.00%. Average daily turnover in May 2006 amounted to CSD 57.19 billion, whereas the average daily number of payments was 648,436, whereof 257,754 were RTGS payments and 390,682 clearing payments.

In May 2006, the number of interbank payments processed in one month reached its highest ever level of 13.62 million payments, whereas the monthly value of interbank payment transactions peaked at USD 1,200.97 billion. May 2006 also saw average daily turnover and average daily number of interbank payments reach record highs of CSD 57.19 billion and 648.436, respectively.

Out of a total of 13.62 million interbank payments processed in the previous month, 8.2 million or 60.25% were clearing orders, and 5.41 million or 39.75% were RTGS payments. The daily clearing payment average value in May 2006 equaled CSD 3.43 billion.
