Pursuant to Article 108 of the Law on Public Procurement (RS Official Gazette, Nos 124/12, 14/2015 and 68/2015, hereinafter: LPP), Article 45 of the Rulebook on Procurements in the National Bank of Serbia (G. No 1545 of 13 March 2014, G. No 5808 of 4 August 2014, G. No 7575 of 12 October 2015, G. No 9906 of 30 December 2016 and G. No 8246 of 29 September 2017) and Article 18 of the Law on the National Bank of Serbia (RS Official Gazette, Nos 72/2003, 55/2004, 85/2005 – other law, 44/2010, 76/2012, 106/2012, 14/2014 and 40/2015 – CC decision and 44/2018), I hereby adopt the following

DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD PP 333/2019

1. In the procedure of public procurement of services – servicing and spare parts for the maintenance of DataCard equipment, PP 333/2019, the Contract is hereby awarded to the bidder Intercard AG, Baslerstrasse 102, CH 8048 Zürich, Switzerland.
2. The value of the public procurement contract is: RSD 15,000,000.00 exclusive of VAT for a period of two years (in accordance with Article 2, paragraph 7 of the Model Contract, estimated value of the public procurement).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The procedure of the public procurement of services – servicing and spare parts for the maintenance of DataCard equipment, PP 333/2019, was initiated by the Decision G. No 1008 of 4 April 2019 (hereinafter: Decision).

The total estimated value of the public procurement specified by the Decision is RSD 15,000,000.00 exclusive of VAT for a period of two years.

On 8 March 2019, the invitation to bid and the Tender Documents were published on the Public Procurement Portal, portal.ujn.gov.rs, and the website of the contracting authority (www.nbs.rs), and the invitation was also published on the Portal of official gazettes of the Republic of Serbia and regulations databases.

In due time, i.e. by 8 April 2019 by 11.00 a.m. a bid was received by the bidder Intercard AG, Baslerstrasse 102, CH 8048 Zürich, registration number CHE-105.948.852, TIN CHE-105.948.852, registered under No 146 of 3 April 2019 at 2.15 p.m.

In the review and expert assessment of the bid, it was established that the bid meets all of the requirements in the LPP and Tender Documents.

Article 3, paragraph 1, item 33) of the LPP defines the acceptable bid as a bid which is timely, not rejected by the contracting authority due to essential deficiencies, which is appropriate, which does not restrict or condition either the rights of the contracting authority or the obligations of the bidder, and which does not exceed the amount of the estimated value of the public procurement.

Considering that only one acceptable bid was received, the ranking of acceptable bids was not performed by applying the “lowest offered price” criterion.

Article 107, paragraph 3 of the LPP prescribes that following the expert assessment of bids and based on the report of the Committee, the contracting authority makes the decision on awarding the contract, if it has received at least one acceptable bid.

Based on the review and expert assessment of the bid, conducted in accordance with the LPP and the Tender Documents, in its Report on the Expert Assessment of Bids (PP 333/2019), registered under No XVII/2-46/12/19 of 12 April 2019, the Committee established by the Decision (G. No 1010 of 4 February 2019), proposed that the procedure for the low-value public procurement of services - servicing and spare parts for the maintenance of DataCard equipment, be concluded by adopting the Decision to award the contract to the bidder Intercard AG, Baslerstrasse 102, CH 8048 Zürich, Switzerland.

In view of the above, the decision was made as stated in the main part of this Decision.
