Pursuant to Article 108 of the Law on Public Procurements (RS Official Gazette Nos. 124/12, 14/2015 and 68/2015, hereinafter: LPP), Article 45 of the Rulebook on Procurements in the National Bank of Serbia (G No. 1545 dated 13 March 2014, G No. 5808 dated 4 August 2014, G No. 7575 dated 12 October 2015, G No. 9906 dated 30 December 2016 and G No. 8246 dated 29 September 2017) and Article 18 of the Law on the National Bank of Serbia (RS Official Gazette Nos 72/2003, 55/2004, 85/2005 – oth. law, 44/2010, 76/2012, 106/2012, 14/2015, 20/2015 – the decision of the CC and 44/2018), I hereby make the following

**DECISION  
ON CONTRACT AWARD  
regarding the public procurement PP 464/2018**

1. The contract for the open public procurement of goods – Spare bath for electrolytes filtration and decantation for the Institute for Manufacturing Banknotes and Coins - Topčider, PP 464/2018, is hereby awarded to the bidder: KBA – NotaSys SA, Avenue du Grey 55, CH – 1018 Lausanne, PO Box 347, CH – 1000 Lausanne 22, Switzerland.
2. The value of the public procurement contract amounts to EUR 88,610.00 excluding VAT, which equals RSD 10,461,606.74 excluding VAT (calculated using the official middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia valid on the bid opening date – 8 March 2019: EUR 1 = RSD 118.0635).

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

The open public procurement of goods – Spare bath for electrolytes filtration and decantation for the Institute for Manufacturing Banknotes and Coins - Topčider, PP 464/2018 was initiated by the Decisions on Initiating the Public Procurement Procedure (G No. 10510 of 11 December 2018, G No. 10938 of 26 December 2018, G No. 11077 of 31 December 2018 and G No. 1382 of 13 February 2019 – hereinafter: Decision).

The total estimated value of the procurement determined by the Decision was RSD 14,000,000.00 excluding VAT.

On 25 January 2019 the Invitation to Bid and the Tender Documents were posted on the Public Procurements Portal (<http://portal.ujn.gov.rs>) and the webpage of the National Bank of Serbia ([www.nbs.rs](http://www.nbs.rs), link Tenders), and the Invitation to Bid was also posted on the RS Official Gazettes and Legal Databases Portal. The bid submission term was set for 25 February 2019 by 11:00. This deadline was extended to 8 March 2019 by 11:00 by the Decision on the Extension of the Bid Submission Term G No. 1382 of 13 February 2019.

Timely, i.e. by 8 March 2019 by 11:00 the bid of the following bidder was received:

KBA – NotaSys SA, Avenue du Grey 55, CH-1018 Lausanne, PO Box 347, CH-1000 Lausanne 22, Switzerland (ID No. CHE - 105.759.995, tax ID No. H970700998), and registered in the National Bank of Serbia as document No. 77 on 4 March 2019 at 14:30; the total offered price in this bid was EUR 88,610.00 excluding VAT (which equals RSD 10,461,606.74 excluding VAT, calculated using the official middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia valid on the bid opening date – 8 March 2019: EUR 1 = RSD 118.0635).

During the examination and expert appraisal of the bid submitted by the bidder KBA – NotaSys SA, Avenue du Grey 55, CH-1018 Lausanne, PO Box 347, CH-1000 Lausanne 22, Switzerland, the Committee established by the Decisions G No. 10511 of 11 December 2018 and G No. 10939 of 28 December 2018 – hereinafter: the Committee, concluded that the bid met all the requirements stipulated in the LPP and the Tender Documents, which is why it was appraised as acceptable.

Article 3, paragraph 1, item 32) of the LPP stipulates that “adequate bid shall mean bid which is timely and determined to fully comply with all technical specifications”.

Article 3, paragraph 1, item 33) of the LPP stipulates that “acceptable bid shall mean bid which is timely, one that contracting authority did not reject due to essential deficiencies, which is adequate, one that does not restrict or condition either the rights of contracting authority or the obligations of bidder, and which does not exceed the amount of estimated value of concrete public procurement”.

Article 107, paragraph 2 of the LPP stipulates that “the contracting authority shall rank acceptable bids by applying the criterion for awarding the contract defined in the call for competition and the tender documents”.

Bid ranking was not done, as there was only one acceptable bid received.

Article 107, paragraph 3 of the LPP stipulates that after having performed expert evaluation of bids, contracting authority makes decision on awarding the contract, if it has received at least one acceptable bid.

Based on the examination and appraisal of the bid conducted in conformity with the LPP and the Tender Documents, the Committee in charge of the subject public procurement (PP 464/2018) suggested in its Report on the Expert Evaluation of Bids (XVII/1-79/17/19 of 12 March 2019) that the contract for purchase and sale of Spare bath for electrolytes filtration and decantation for the Institute for Manufacturing Banknotes and Coins - Topčider, be awarded to the bidder KBA – NotaSys SA, Avenue du Grey 55, CH-1018 Lausanne, PO Box 347, CH-1000 Lausanne 22, Switzerland.

In view of the above said, the decision was made as stated in the main part of this Decision.

Legal remedy:

Against this Decision the bidder may submit the request for the protection of rights to the contracting authority within 10 days from posting this Decision on the Public Procurements Portal.
